



**APPLICATION FOR PERSONS WISHING TO REPRESENT STAKEHOLDERS IN THE

Nyahururu Water and Sanitation Company (NYAHUWASCO) is a public water utility company that was incorporated on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2002 under the Companies Act, 2015 (formerly Cap 486). The Company is mandated to provide water and sanitation services in Laikipia County and is fully owned by the County Government of Laikipia under the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

The Board of Directors comprise of representatives of stakeholders identified in accordance with the Corporate Governance Guidelines issued by the Water Services Regulatory Board (WASREB).

The Board has vacancies for representatives of the following stakeholders: -

- i. **One (1) Director nominated by Rural Schemes within service provision area of the company**
- ii. **One (1) Director nominated by the manufacturing and business community**
- iii. **One (1) Director nominated by professional organizations**
- iv. **One (1) Director nominated by resident organizations**
- v. **One (1) Director nominated by the registered women organizations, youth and persons with special needs.**

The Company seeks to fill the vacant positions for the Board of Directors and therefore invites applications from nominees of the above stakeholders.

The applicants should meet the following criteria: -

- I. Minimum holder of a Bachelor's degree from a recognized university in Kenya or equivalent Professional qualification.
- II. Demonstrated experience and acumen in business or any profession for at least 7 years.
- III. Must be nominated by a stakeholder group registered with NYAHUWASCO.
- IV. Be a resident of the area served by the company.
- V. Must meet the Fit and Proper Test criteria by WASREB available on WASREB's website [www.wasreb.co.ke](http://www.wasreb.co.ke). The submitted copy MUST be fully signed by the applicant and stamped by a commissioner of oaths or magistrate.
- VI. Must meet leadership and integrity criteria under Chapter 6 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 (attach the following current documents – issued within the last 12 months)
  - a) Certificate of Good Conduct (DCI)
  - b) Clearance Certificate from Accredited Credit Reference Bureau (CRB)
  - c) Clearance Certificate from Higher Education Loans Board (HELB)
  - d) Tax Compliance Certificate (KRA)
  - e) Clearance Certificate from Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC)

**Note:**

1. Suppliers and other trading associates of the Company are not eligible for directorship positions at the company.
2. Persons in current professional or social relationships with directors of the Company cannot become directors of the Company.
3. Nominating organizations are encouraged to nominate women for consideration to ensure one-third gender rule as required under the Constitution.
